



## Bankstown Memorial Park and City Gardens, Bankstown 2007 Bankstown City Council



Oval

In 2007 Bankstown City Council engaged Sturt Noble Associates to review, revise and update the Bankstown Memorial Park and City Gardens Plan of Management, 1999. This included the preparation of a revised Master Plan.

The entire site is over 7 hectares and incorporates Memorial Oval, Bankstown City Gardens and the Memorial Park Outer Ground including Grahame Thomas Oval.

The revised Plan of Management addresses:

- Formalising Memorial Park as Bankstown's regional cricket facility.
- Identifying Memorial Oval as the site for the establishment of a regional cricket academy
- Development of Bankstown Memorial Park and City Gardens as a district park that meets the active and passive recreational needs of the CBD Retention of Bankstown Memorial Park and City Garden's role as an iconic city-wide park for the residents of Bankstown.
- Continuation of Bankstown Memorial Park and City Gardens as the gateway to the City as identified in the CBD Masterplan.
