Cumberland Park, Edmondson Park 2011-2012 Landcom

Sturt Noble Associates was engaged by Landcom to document the public open space in Stage 1 of their new land release at Edmondson Park.

Cumberland Park is envisaged as an engaging, native landscape with high levels of activity. The design integrates a fitness circuit, adventure play, bush trails and a primary pedestrian commuter path.

The lower part of the park accommodates these more active components in addition to a BBQ area, shelters and seating as well a large kickaround lawn area.

A large remnant area of existing Cumberland plain woodland has been retained where possible and enhanced with revegetation of endemic plantings. Access paths are carefully located through this zone.

Public art has been integrated into the park and artwork based on commemorative military medals and ribbons has been integrated into our design detailing through bandings of glazed brick feature walls and painted totems.
