

Point Park, Rhodes, 2005-2010, Meriton Apartments

Sturt Noble Associates was engaged by Meriton Apartments to design and document this significant foreshore open space at the northern end of the Rhodes Peninsula. The park allows for passive recreation and offers a number of viewing and seating areas to capitalise on the views to Shepherd's Bay, Meadowbank and along the Parramatta River.

A continuous corridor of open space is provided with pedestrian and cycle links extending from Bicentennial Park in the south, through to the Leeds Street Foreshore on the northern boundary.

The history of the site is acknowledged via a shelter structure including laser cut wheat sheaves and a series of sandstone feed sacks installed by Jane Cavanagh (Artlandish) along with Sturt Noble Associates pre-cast concrete feature walls, decorated with a representation of the now demolished mill building.
