

Inmark Tower, George Street, Sydney 2009



Level 19 Terrace

Sturt Noble Associates were commissioned by Inmark to develop a landscape plan for a19 storey commercial and residential apartment highrise in the Sydney CBD. The development includes a retail atrium, green wall and roof top outdoor space.

The atrium is flanked to the south by a 3 storey green wall. Planter boxes will support a range of climbers trained up a wire trellis system and create a green frame to the coloured glass louvres commissioned by artist Robert Owen.

The Level 19 terrace provides a timber decking platform with custom design timber seating wrapped around the edge.

A range of succulent plants with their strong architectural forms were utilised including Dragon Trees (Draceana draco), Agaves, Echeveria, colourful Lampranthus, Kalanchoe and the striking Yucca elephantipes. These will cope with the hot, dry and windy conditions of this city rooftop.
