Garden beds and concrete seatting units to front courtyard

Sturt Noble Associates in association with Suters Architects was engaged by BHSC to design and document all the landscape works and public realm facilities for the new Council offices.

The Key landscape element is the Entry Courtyard with planted islands on the existing podium incorporating bench seating and insitu/ precast concrete planter wall elements. Timber composite decking delineates the café and seating areas and softens the large expanses of paving of this enclosed podium area.

Planter beds were mounded to provide sufficient soil depths for the planting of small feature trees given the constraints of retrofitting an existing building precluded landscape setdowns.
