

## Bardia Reserve, Edmondson Park 2011-2012 Landcom

Sturt Noble Associates was engaged by Landcom to document the public open space in Stage 1 of their new land release at Edmondson Park.

Bardia Park is envisaged as a welcome to future residents of Edmondson Park South.

A large entry feature including a feature wall and significant feature Fig Tree; provide a sense of entry to the site. Public art has been integrated into this feature wall based on commemorative military medals and ribbons through bandings of glazed brick feature walls.

Different to the riparian corridor, Bardia Park forms a transition from endemic to european vegetation. The lower part of the park accommodates passive usage including shelters and seating as well a large kickaround lawn area.

Remnant Cumberland plain woodland has been retained where possible and enhanced with revegetation of both endemic plantings and new exotic feature plantings.
