Sturt Noble were engaged to master plan and design all landscape elements for this new planned residential estate.

This included open space areas including Bardia Park, Brigade Park and Valley Reserve. Our team developed the entire entry experience including the main entry, sales office, streetscapes and urban design treatments for superlots.

Brigade Park Park is envisaged as an engaging, native landscape with high levels of activity; and integrates a fitness circuit, adventure play, bush trails and a primary pedestrian commuter path. The lower part of the park accommodates BBQ area, shelters and seating as well a large kickaround lawn area.

Bardia Park is envisaged as a welcome to future residents of Edmondson Park South.

A large entry feature including a feature wall and significant feature Fig Tree; provide a sense of entry to the site.

Valley Reserve is a free, unstructured space for local residents with dogs to explore. Safe and protected informal paths take walkers on a journey through an open woodland setting.

Public art has been integrated into the parks and artwork based on commemorative military medals and ribbons has been integrated into our designs detailing through bandings of glazed brick feature walls and painted totems.
