The Wallarah Peninsula residential development is located south of Newcastle. The site covers 605 hectares of land, bounded by the Pacific Ocean and Lake Macquarie, and provides panoramic views over the ocean, lake and bushland.

Over the last 10 years, a master planned community for all age groups has been established to integrate the concepts of conservation with sustainable urban development. A series of local village settlements are being built on the natural beauty of the landscapes of the Peninsula, encouraging the community to enjoy and respect the expanses of the protected bushland, wildlife habitat and open spaces.

Sturt Noble Associates were engaged to undertake bushland management plans and detailed design of regeneration and revegetation works for this unique project.

In addition we were involved in site planning for residential display homes and developed a number of native garden designs to demonstrate best practice sustainable in this bushland context.
